

COVID-19 Update on Targeted Case Management (TCM)

South Country Health Alliance will provide a temporary increase of 6.2 percent to Targeted Case Management (TCM) rates for some Medical Assistance members. The temporary increase is available for TCM (T2023) services regardless of the modality of contact (for example face-to-face or by telephone). This will include Medical Assistance members that are: children; parents or guardians with children under age 19; individuals age 65 and older; and individuals with disabilities. The increase does not apply to adults without children.

This increase will end on the last day of the calendar quarter in which the federal emergency period ends.
