

Provider Web Portal Medical Accumulators

The South Country Health Alliance (South Country) provider web portal currently displays home care skilled nursing, hearing aid, breast pump, hospice election, and chiropractic accumulators.

Home Care Accumulators

Home care accumulators are displayed by showing the number of South Country paid homecare skilled nursing visits (T1030), home health aide (T1021), and home therapies (S9128, S9129, S9131) for members in Families and Children, MinnesotaCare, and SingleCare or SharedCare programs. Members in these programs are allowed **nine visits per calendar year**. Once this limit is met, any additional visits require a service authorization.

Hearing aid accumulators

Hearing aid accumulators are determined by a procedure code that identifies a monaural or set of binaural hearing aids and paid claims data for the **past three years**.

The original dispense date identifies the date of service on which the first monaural or set of binaural hearing aids were dispensed.

Breast Pump Accumulators

Breast pump accumulators are determined by the procedure code E0603 for electric breast pump and are limited to **one every year**.

Hospice election accumulators

If a member has elected hospice, the accumulator will display as "*M-Hospice Election Individual*" and will include the date the member elected hospice. If there is no indication under the medical accumulator section of the hospice election, it means South Country has not yet been notified of the member's hospice election.

Chiropractic accumulators

South Country follows the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS) requirement

for prior authorization of chiropractic services **after 24 manipulations per year and after 6 manipulations per month.** Note: If the accumulator displays a count over the allowed units, it means South Country Health Alliance has authorized additional units.

Mammogram Screening

South Country allows <u>one mammogram screening</u>, every <u>five rolling years</u>, for members enrolled in our **AbilityCare program between the ages of 35-39**. This count will be shown for AbilityCare members in the provider portal.

*As a benefit anyone (regardless of product) age 40 and older is allowed 1 in every one rolling year, however this does not display as an accumulator in the portal.
