Community Engagement in Steele County & Sibley County



Steele County

Steele County completed Gap Analysis 2022 Resulted in 3 action teams:

- I. Affordable Housing
- II. Racial Division
- III. Teen Mental Health*

*Subgroup = Opioid Action Team



Racial Division Workgroup

- Mission driven leaders throughout Steele County meet routinely to build a logic model and measurable outcomes to bridge the gap in equity and engage in community conversation.
 - This group is merging with a pre-existing group called AGE, Alliance for Greater Equity.



Opioid Action Team

Opioid action team is a collaboration of several community organizations in Steele County including law enforcement, public health, a local pharmacy, school staff, substance use treatment providers and emergency medical services

- Created opioid resources for Steele County members
- Posted an educational tip sheet for teens
- Provided free naloxone education and distributed free kits to community individuals
- Creating a video with community members and families who have lived experience with substance use and recovery to be shared with the community and schools



Sibley County Collaboration

- South Country established grant funds with Sibley
 - Community health worker
 - Focus on diabetes and LatinX
- Working together on community health assessment
- Collaboration on Community Engagement and Trainings
 - Bridges Out of Poverty training
 - Advisory Committee
 - Other events 2024

Also: Providers addressing HRSN

Health related social needs (HRSN): social aspects that can affect a person's overall health.

Provider Network Medical Record Reviews:

- 1.) Providers screening for social determinants of health (SDoH) needs
- 2.) If any SDoH are identified, is there a discussion, referral or intervention that addresses the concern



Other Equity Activities

- Delfina addresses equitable maternal health
- Developing internal and external messaging on health equity initiatives and outcomes.
- Data driven initiatives to address health care disparities in South Country members.
