

## 2019 Changes Specific to Elderly Waiver Providers

### Billing

- **2018 Dates of Service** must be billed through MN-Its:  
<https://mn-its.dhs.state.mn.us/>
- **2019 Dates of Service** must be billed electronically to South Country with payer ID #81600

Providers who do not have the ability to create a HIPAA electronic transaction can register with HealthEC a.k.a. MN E-Connect ([www.mneconnect.healthec.com](http://www.mneconnect.healthec.com)) and use the online data entry system to file claims electronically.

Effective January 1, 2019 we will be following MN Statute 62Q.75 requiring providers to bill South Country within 6 months from the date of service.

Effective January 1, 2019 members on an Elderly Waiver with an obligation can designate one provider to pay their waiver obligation to.

As always, you may receive a copy of the care plan or summary of the services you are approved to provide to Elderly Waiver members. This can be requested from and sent to you by the members Elderly Waiver Care Coordinator.
